

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type blade carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is roughly 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades can differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
